JOB POSTING: Summer Musical Theatre Program Instructor

The **Arts Club Theatre Company** is one of Canada's most successful professional theatre companies and the largest in Western Canada. This non-profit, charitable organization presents plays year-round in three theatres: the Granville Island Stage on Granville Island, the Goldcorp Stage, and the Stanley Industrial Alliance Stage. The Arts Club also has an extensive provincial touring program.

The Arts Club Theatre Company is currently accepting applications for the position of Summer Musical Theatre Program Instructor for a new educational program to be offered in the summer of 2017. We are looking for an instructor to teach 14 theatre students, entering grades 5 – 7 this fall. The program will run 9 am – 3 pm on weekdays for two weeks from July 10th to 21st, 2017. This program, entitled Kids Theatre Lab at the Arts Club, is in partnership with the Vancouver School Board and will be held at an East Vancouver High School.

Responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to the following:

- Developing a course outline to demonstrate a versatile and adaptive program with an emphasis on student engagement and collaboration.
- Setting up and striking rehearsal halls/classrooms.
- Ability to teach a range of musical theatre skills to youth.
- Ability to provide a flexible program model that is able to follow student engagement and set up a classroom environment where the students are able to participate in course goals and output.
- Provide feedback and debrief with the Education & Outreach Manager.
- Ability to attend planning meetings.
- Coordinate final showcase details.
- Ability to work with an assistant instructor/accompanist.
- Final Report writing.

Date Range: July 10th to July 21st, 2017. Class runs Monday to Friday once a week from 9 am – 3 pm.

The successful applicant will have teaching experience in acting, singing and movement. The applicant should have at least 3 years of group teaching experience and be able to provide a criminal record check for working with children.
